It is the MPL Technology Summer Camp policy to dismiss a camper in the following circumstances:

- When camp administration determines that the camper needs services and supervision beyond those provided by our camp and our staff.
- When the camper exhibits any of the following behaviors or conditions:

Aggressive or threatening behaviors

Non-compliant behavior

Inappropriate sexual behavior

Bullying

Destruction of property

Participants will not be able to use mobile devices during the course of camp including gaming systems, tablets, and mobile devices. To receive the maximum benefit of the technology camp attendance is critical. Notify the library as soon as possible in the event that you will not be able to attend a camp session or will not be on time.
